## **Introduction**

Welcome to the Rallycross Tyro National (RTN) 2008! The RTN is a new innovation that provides an exciting opportunity for the club racer to compete in a series that will mimic the format of BRCA Rallycross National events. It is an ideal stepping-stone for the racer who takes his/her racing seriously and wants to move on to the next level. This is something that many of you have been asking for, and now, at last, it's here!

## **Who Can Enter**

To be eligible for registration, you must not have entered any BRCA National event in 2008. Any driver that has finished in the top 24 of any previous BRCA National series, and/or made more than one National A Final, cannot enter the RTN.

## **How to Enter**

Entries will only be accepted on the official registration and entry form. The entry form must be completed in full, including the signed declaration. Entries will open on 20th January 2008 and will only be accepted by post to the RTN secretary, whose address is on the form. Entries fees must be paid in full when submitting the entry form. There is a mandatory one-off £10 registration fee payable at the same time.

Entries will be confirmed by post (see details on entry form), together with additional useful information about each host club. Entries will be allocated upon receipt by post and will be capped at 100 per meeting plus 10 reserves.

Arrangements for overnight camping are your own responsibility, and any enquiries should be directed to the host club.

## **Rules and Regulations**

Whilst the emphasis will be on fun and enjoyment for all concerned, there is a serious side to the RTN, which has been designed to mimic the BRCA National series as closely as possible. Therefore, it is likely that the overall standard of each meeting together with driver/pit crew conduct (on and off the track) may well be to a higher level than you may have previously experienced. It is therefore essential that you, and your pit crew, read and learn your 2008 Rallycross Handbook, so that you are fully au fait with the rules and the way in which a National is run. There will be some exceptions to these rules at certain venues, but these will be explained at drivers' briefing on the day.

The RTN will consist of 6 Rounds, with 4 to count culminating with a non-scoring Presentation Day meeting.

Scoring will also be to BRCA National rules. Awards will be presented to the top 10 overall at the Presentation Day, and all drivers competing in 4 events or more will receive a personal achievement award, charting their progress through the Series.

## **Marshalling**

It is especially important that drivers and pit crews in the RTN understand how they must conduct themselves on and off the track, and this includes marshalling. This has been a major issue in the past at some club-level meetings and the RTN aim to help all competitors to 'raise their game' so that these duties are carried out fairly, correctly and above all else, safely.

Read your BRCA Rallycross Handbook, learn the rules, and keep to them!

Please remember that by entering this Series and signing the reverse of this entry form, you acknowledge that you have read and accepted the regulations, including the rules and related penalties for marshalling. Ignorance of the rules is no excuse!

If you are unsure about anything, please ask one of the officials on the day, and if you are a newcomer to the sport, please make yourself known to one of the stewards immediately after drivers briefing. They are there to help and not just to administer penalties!
